

Game Day Rules

The Betsy Lewis Tennis Challenge is intended to be a FUN tournament. Relax, have a good time. Enjoy the tennis.

The Challenge has a unique format. If after reading the instructions, you have any questions, please ask an on-site "orange hat" commissioner for help.

5 minute warm up - Strictly enforced

USTA game rules apply

According to the names shown on the scorecard, play one set of men's and women's doubles simultaneously on the two assigned courts. Then, according to the scorecard, play sets of mixed doubles simultaneously on the same two courts.

Note: If one court finishes before the other, DO NOT LEAVE THE COURT. Continue playing for fun and be ready to start the next set quickly.

Upon completion, the winner of the most sets wins. If the set score is tied at 2-2, then use the score card to add up game scores. The team with the highest number of games wins. If in an unlikely scenario game scores are tied, then the designated teams (see score card) play a 5 point tie-breaker (first to 5 by 2). The winner of the tie-breaker wins the match.

Upon completion of the match, please return the balls and scorecard to the registration table.
